

Proceedings of the 49th Annual General Body Meeting of the Institution of Agricultural Technologists, Bengaluru for the year 2020-21 held on Saturday, 18.12.2021 at 3:00 P.M. at Dr. H.R. Arakeri Auditorium.

1. Welcome

The Secretary Sri. R. Ramamurthy extended a hearty and warm welcome to the President Prof. V. Veerabhadraiah, Vice President Dr. G. Eswarappa, Joint Secretary, Sri. Siddaraju all the members of the Managing Committee present, all the life members and requested the President Prof. V. Veerabhadraiah to preside and conduct the meeting.

Prof. V. Veerabhadraiah, the President once again extended a warm welcome to all the members present. Total number of members present was 157 only. Since there was no required quorum (1/10 of the total membership), the President adjourned the meeting for 30 minutes as per the bye-law.

The house observed two minutes silence in reverence to the departed life members of the IAT.

2. To read the Notice calling for the 49th Annual General Body Meeting

The Secretary readout the Notice dated 11-11-2021 which was sent to the members, earlier.

3. Confirmation of the Proceedings of the 48th Annual General Body Meeting held on 25-03-2021 and action taken thereon

Sri.R.Ramamurthy, the Secretary placed the proceedings before the Annual General Body the proceedings of the 48th Annual General Body Meeting held on 25-03-2021 for the year 2019-20 before the AGM as given in pages 5 to 11 of the General Body Meeting printed booklet, and briefly highlighted the important points there on and requested the members to confirm the same along with the action taken report as given on page 11 of the report.

The Secretary clarified a few points as requested by some members. Sri.K.Badappa proposed and seconded by Sri.B.L.Lokeshappa for confirmation and approval of the proceedings and the Action Taken report. The General Body unanimously approved the Proceedings of the 48th Annual General Body Meeting along with the action taken report.

4. Presentation and adoption of the Annual Report for the period ending March 2021

The Secretary presented the report of the activities of the Institution and that of the Regional Chapters for the year 2020-21 as furnished on pages 12 to 21 of the General Body meeting booklet and requested for discussion, if any, and approval.



The Secretary clarified that due to pandemic Covid 19 prevailed during the period under report, only limited programmes were organized including some online programmes. Few Regional Chapters organized very good programmes during the Period. The President also informed the members in detail about the financial crisis, epidemic restrictions etc. However, minimum programmes could be carried out with good response from members.

After the above clarification, Sri.D.Manjanna proposed and Sri.G.Sreekantan seconded for approval and then the General Body unanimously approved and adopted the annual report of the activities for the period ending 2020-21 including the action taken on the suggestions from the members as discussed in the 48th Annual General Body Meeting held on 25-3-2021 as given on page 11.

5. To Present and to adopt the audited Statement of Accounts, Annual Balance Sheet and also the Income and Expenditure Account as on 31st March 2021

The Secretary Sri.R.Ramamurthy in place of Sri.D.Krishnappa, Treasurer presented the audited report pertaining to the Receipts and Payment, Income and Expenditure and the Balance Sheet of the Accounts for the year 2020-21 as furnished on pages 22 to 33 of the Booklet and requested the members to approve the same.

The Secretary informed the august body that as already informed in the previous Annual General Body meeting held on 25-03-2021, the income was reduced during the period of 9 months ending March 2021 very drastically and added to this, the tenants M/s. St.Xaviers Educational and Charitable Trust, Bengaluru also not only delayed/denied the payment of monthly rent/lease amount as previously agreed, fixed but also sought several concessions and reductions since the Educational Institution could not work. They expected several concessions/reduced rates of rent, waiving off.

The members being satisfied with the facts and figures given with clarifications Sri.S.A.Govinda Reddy proposed and Sri.A.Thippeswamy seconded for the approval of the annual balance sheet as on 31-3.3021 and Income and Expenditure report and the General Body unanimously considered and approved the balance sheet.

6. Ratification of expenditure incurred by the Managing Committee during the year 2020-21 exceeding the powers of the Managing Committee

The Secretary on behalf of the Treasurer requested the General Body to ratify the expenditure incurred by the Managing Committee during 2020-21 that exceeded the powers of Managing Committee as given on page 33 of the Booklet (5 items).

After brief clarification, Sri.K.Badappa proposed and Sri.A.P. Nagaraju seconded for approval. The General Body unanimously approved and ratified the expenditure incurred by the Managing Committee for the period ending 31-3-2021 which exceeded the powers of the Managing Committee.

7. To approve the proposed budget for the year 2022-2

The Secretary placed the proposed budget for the year 2022-23 as given on pages 34 and 35 of the Booklet before the AGM for approval.

The Secretary explained that hiring out of accommodation has now gradually picking up and the income is likely to increase subject to the epidemic prevailing Covid and the Government restrictions. Sri.R.Thippeswamy of Davanagere, Sri.Gurusiddamurthy of Bellary and Venkataramanappa participated in the discussion and requested for release of grants to Regional Chapters to organize more farmer oriented programmes. The Secretary in his reply stated that looking to the financial position will release grants to Regional Chapters always if specific request for conducting programmes / proposals are received, but the Regional Chapters, however, will have to mobilize their resources as far as possible in their districts. IAT will also release grants to all the need based programmes etc.

With the above discussion and replies, Sri.S.A.Govinda Reddy proposed and Sri.B.T.Rama Reddy seconded for the approval and there upon the General Body unanimously approved the proposed budget for the year 2022-23 including that of the endowment programmes.

8. To approve Auditors to audit the accounts for the year 2021-22 and fix their remuneration

The Secretary proposed for the continuation of the present auditors M/s.M.A.Narasimhan & Co, Bengaluru instead of the previous auditors and explained the need and justified the same and pay their remuneration(Rs.20,000/- + Rs.3600 (GST 18%) = Rs.23,600/-)

With the justification given Sri.B.L.Lokeshappa proposed and Sri.R.Keshavamurthy seconded for approval and the General Body approved unanimously the proposals and authorized the Managing Committee to pay the reasonable remuneration based on the quantum of work involved.

9. To consider the written proposals received by the Secretary, if any

1. Letter from Regional Chapter, Davanagere

The representatives Sri.R.Thippeswamy and Sri.Revanasiddappa requested to treat the loan of Rs.2.5 lakhs as grants. Sri.Made Gowda, member supported the request. The Secretary stated the subject has already been discussed at length in the previous AGM and in the Managing Committee and stated that a sufficient time will be given to repay the amount without any interest.

Sri. H.S. Krishnamurthy from Mysuru with his experience explained and stated that there should be a clear cut policy on this issue by the Institution. There should not be repeated requests, precedence etc. by the Regional Chapters one after another and requests for the waiving off of the loan later to be avoided and provision in the proposed budget be indicated clearly for the Regional Chapter programmes.

With the above discussions the Regional Chapter, Davanagere was permitted to repay the loan in a phased manner.

2. Letters from Bagalkote, Belagavi, Vijayapura, Bellary, Bidar and Shivamogga Regional Chapters.

Representatives from the above chapters stated that election process to be revised giving way for atleast 4 revenue divisions to contest the elections to the Managing Committee and or the elections to be held there itself to elect their members to Managing Committee at Bengaluru so that the Managing Committee represents all over the state.



The President stated that already co-opted members from different Regional Chapters are there and such things needs time, procedure and amendment of bye-law. He also stated that provision of postal ballot voting facility is already in the use.

Members have also suggested for adopting digital voting.

The President stated further that a sub-committee under the Chairmanship of Dr.M.A.Shankar has been formed to look into this issue. The committee is working out the details. Dr.M.A.Shankar stated that sufficient time is involved in the process and needs a detailed thinking in the matter.

9. Any other subjects with the permission of the chair.

The Secretary informed that the building on the Queen's road side has been given on rent after observing all the formalities to M/s.St.Xaviers Educational and Charitable Trust, an educational Institution. Later on due to prevailing epidemic and time to time conditions imposed by the government as they could not start and run the college, concessions waiving off rent etc. also has been given. They have sent a legal letter/notice that they have already spent sufficient amount to build up their specifically needed infrastructure facilities and wanted concession/ waiving of rent etc.

The Secretary appraised for the year 2020-21, IAT has waived offthe rent for the months of April-May 2020 due to Covid-19 lockdown situation and accepted rent of 50% for the months from June 2020 to March 2021 extending a total concession rent of Rs.21.00 lakhs and no interest levied on the delayed payment. Same was noted and action taken by the Managing Committee was approved by the AGM.

After a brief discussion and participation by a few members, the General Body authorized the Managing Committee to immediately proceed as per mutually accepted rent agreement and according to the byelaw which is very clear that the Managing Committee itself can take further action in the matter in the best interest of the IAT, Bengaluru. The General Body resolved that the Tenant should pay the rent as per Agreement and Managing Committee may initiate action as deemed fit in the existing situation.

Regarding the grant of land to Regional Chapter, Dharwad by the Government, the Regional Chapter representative requested for early action for which the Secretary stated that the recommendation has been done in the matter.

10. Address by the President.

The President in his brief address thanked all the life members for their active participation and valuable suggestions. He thanked the Office Bearers, Managing Committee members and office staff for their excellent cooperation in conducting the AGM.

11. Vote of thanks.

Sri.R. Ramamurthy, Secretary proposed vote of thanks to the Chair, office bearers, Managing Committee members, life members present for their active participation and suggestions given.

He also thanked all the office staff for their involvement in the conducting of the AGM smoothly without any hassle.

Then the President declared that the AGM is closed.



Report on the various activities of Institution of Agricultural Technologists, Bengaluru and its Regional Chapters for the year 2021-22 (April 2021- March 2022)

The Activities conducted by IAT are grouped into three parts.

Part I. Activities in General

- a) `The Governing Body of the Institution shall be the Managing Committee (M.C.). The administration and Management of the Institution shall vest with the Managing Committee consisting of 15 elected members, two co-opted members, four Presidents or nominees co-opted from four Regional Chapters on yearly rotation basis and 15 ex-officio members. The elected members from among themselves choose the President, two Vice-Presidents, Secretary, Joint Secretary and Treasurer as office bearers.
- b) `The Managing Committee is supported with 9 sub- committees for easy implementation of various activities/ programmes. The Managing Committee meets every month regularly to review the activities implemented by different sub-committees and extend required support / guidance. The activities planned by different sub-committees have been carried out effectively. Monthly and cumulative yearly Income and Expenditures were reviewed on monthly basis. On account of prevailing noval Corona virus (Covid-19) pandemic situation during 2021-22 much of the physical activities could not be conducted as per the directions of Government of India as well as Government of Karnataka. However, regular Managing Committee meetings were conducted both physically and virtually. During the year 2021-22 a total of 11 Managing Committee meetings were conducted.
- c) `In addition to Central Committee at Benglauru, IAT has formed 19 Regional Chapters at different districts. Regional Chapters are supported with Financial assistance to conduct different activities. The Center has also supported the Regional Chapters like Chitradurga, Davanagere, Vijayapura, Belagavi, Shivamogga and Mysuru to procure sites and construct buildings for the use and benefit of the respective chapters.

d) 49th Annual General Body Meeting of IATBengaluru for the year 2020-21 held on 18.12.2022.

AGM confirmed the minutes of the 48th AGM meeting held on 25.03.2021, considered and adopted (1)Annual activities report for the period ending March 2021. (2)Annual balance sheet & Income & Expenditure account as on 31st march 2021 (3)Approved the budget proposal for the year 2022-23. (4)Approved to appoint auditors for the year 2021-22. (5)Ratified the expenditure incurred by the M.C during the year 2020-21, exceeding the powers of managing committee.

e) Inauguration of New IAT Regional Chapter at Hassan

The Hassan chapter was inaugurated on 15-12-2021. During this programme and General body meeting, President of IAT, Bangalore Prof. Veerabhadraiah, Vice President Dr. Eshawarappa G, Secretary Sri.R. Ramamurthy, Sri. Veeranna Kamatar, and Sri. Siddalingappa were present. The office bearers of the Regional Chapter Hassan also elected unanimously during this programme. The Dr. S.N Vasudevan, Dean (Agri.), College of Agriculture, Hassan was elected as President, Sri K.H Ravi, Joint Director of Agriculture, KSDA, Hassan as Vice President.

(i) Webinar on iSTRATEGIES FOR PROMOTING ONE DISTRICT ONE PRODUCT (ODOP) THROUGH SECONDARY AGRICULTURE?

Webinar was organized by Institution of Agricultural Technologists(IAT), Bengaluru on Monday the 12th July 2021 from 10.30 A.M. to 3.45 P.M. in collaboration with KAPPEC, Government of Karnataka and MANAGE, Hyderabad in which, 220 participants have registered for webinar in which 123 have actively participated in the webinar. Dr.G.Eswarappa, Vice President, IAT and Chairman, Programme sub-committee, IAT, Bengaluru has explained the importance of webinar in the present context to develop strategies for ODOP under Aathma Nirbhar Bharat programme and to initiate secondary agriculture for doubling the farmers income by 2022. He also explained different products identified in all the 30 districts of Karnataka.

Dr.P.Chandrashekara, DG, MANAGE inaugurated the webinar as the chief guest. He highlighted the importance of secondary agriculture on One District One Product(ODOP) mode for which Government of India has introduced scheme ODOP to initiate agro-processing units through secondary agriculture. This is one of the flagship programmes for doubling income of farmers by 2022 as envisaged by Government of India under Aathma Nirbhar Bharat Programme. This facilitates FPOis for Self Help Groups(SHG)/NGOis/Agrientrepreneurs /Farm youths to become good entrepreneurs by utilizing financial assistance under Aathma Nirbhar Bharat programme. This helps the farmers who have been identified for the groups particular crops under ODOP, to link the subsidies and financial support from Nationalised Banks as per the guidelines of ODOP and also stressed the importance of HRD under the scheme through nationally recognized institutions and State Farm Universities through hands on training

for self sustainable agriculture processing units at village level, to avoid transportation and handling charges and also middlemen.

He wished this webinar will be successful in reaching the individuals.

Dr.B.N.S.Murthy, Director, IIHR participated as guest of honour in the webinar and he enlightened the ODOP programme at national level under Aathma Nirbhar Bharat programme. Further he highlighted the IIHR activity under ODOP, Karnataka and also stressed the importance of IIHR in HRD activities under horticulture. He also proposed the range of products prepared this IIHR to initiate secondary agriculture for doubling the income of farmers by 2022.

Accordingly 9 resource persons have been identified for panel discussion on different products identified by the Government of Karnataka.
