He suggested to have preventive measures such as Regular food habits, regular exercise, practice to be in a group instead of loneliness, try to be a member of big family group, making good relationship with the family, having self confidence with whatever situation available, acquire knowledge and sharing knowledge with others etc. Further he advised to have love, courage, tolerance, support, contentment, honesty, discipline, selflessness, limited desire and keeping good mental health.
