Born to an agricultural family of Hulakunda Village of Ramadurga Taluk, Belgaum district

Dr. Hanumantha Reddy Arakeri on 5th Aug, 1919 had to pursue both farm work & schooling together as a young boy at Kajjidoni of Vijayapura District.

Later, with a an agriculture degree from Agriculture College, Pune, Dr. H.R. Arakeri served the Dept. of Agriculture of the then Mumbai Govt. from 1940 to 1947. When Mumbai Govt. started Agriculture College at Dharwad, he was appointed as a teacher from where he flew to Minnesota University, US of A where he did his MS & Ph.D.

When the Dharwad Agriculture College was handed over to the then Mysore Govt, Dr. HRA, continued teaching agriculture with an additional responsibility of managing and developing a whopping exent of

President remembers Dr. H.R. Arakeri, the Founder President of IAT

ate Dr. Hanumantha Reddy Arakeri was appointed as the Director of Agriculture in 1966. He had plenty of problems to tackle, mainly with regard to the administrative structure of the department. In 1963, the Department of Horticulture was created and as a result, Horticulture Farms and Schemes were transferred from the Department of Agriculture to newly created Department of Horticulture. Further, with the establishment of UAS Bangalore in 1965, all Research Stations and two Agricultural Colleges were transferred to the University.

Dr. Arakeri initiated the reorganization of the Department of Agriculture. The State Government approved his

proposal for the reorganization setup in January 1967. Owing to this, as many as 30 Gazetted Officers started functioning at the headquarters of the Directorate of Agriculture in Bangalore. The meeting of the officers used to be held in a small conference hall at the Department. During one of such meetings, Dr.Arakeri informed the officers to meet and chat informally once in a week after the office hours over a cup of tea. His idea was that, officers should forget their official worries and relax atleast for some time.

Such informal meetings were held every Monday and Dr.Arakeri presided over the meeting and the Senior Joint Director was the Vice President. There

used to be no official matter, but something related to Agricultural profession.

After a few months, in one of the meetings, Dr. Arakeri informed the officers that there is a need for a professional body on the lines of the Institution of Engineers. This idea was accepted by the officers and started to collect the details of Bye-laws and Rules of the existing professional associations including that of the Institution of Engineers. Late Mr. D.V. Murthy, the then Plant Protection officer collected all the details for the purpose of the registration of the Association. After discussions, the proposed association was named as the Institution of Agricultural Technologists (IAT) and accordingly it was registered under the Societies Act. Mr. D.V. Murthy and his group prepared the Memorandum and Bye-laws of the proposed institution. The graduates in Agricultural Sciences at the Headquarters were enrolled as the members of the Institution. The General body meeting of 30 enrolled members was held on 05th June, 1967 in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Agriculture and the IAT was informally established on that day. However, the IAT was formally registered on 18th Dec, 1968 and hence, 'Foundation Day' of the Institution is being held on that day, every year.

Dr. Arakeri, after initiating the establishment of the IAT, demitted the office of the Director of Agriculture in 1970 as he was appointed as a member of the National Commission on Agriculture. Till 1974, there were

not many activities of the IAT. Dr. R. Dwarakinath took over as the Director of Agriculture in 1974 and at the same time, Dr. Arakeri returned to Bangalore as Vice-Chancellor of the University of Agricultural Sciences. Dr. Dwarakinath took a lot of interest in the activities of the IAT. During that time, Dr. B.J. Nanjundappa was the Secretary and Dr. K. Shankar was the Treasurer. With the efforts of all thesestalwarts, a big site was sanctioned on lease basis for 99 years by the then Bangalore City Corporation in Millers Tank Bed abetting Queensroad.

A building came up on this site and the Auditorium block was inaugurated by

Nobel laureate Dr. Norman E. Borlaug, the renowned Agriculture Scientist in the world.

Late Mr. B. Sreeramappa, former Superintending Engineer and Dr. K. Shankar toiled very hard to bring IAT to this stage. The Managing Committee took a lot of interest in building this Institution from time to time. Late Mr. N. Chikkegowda, who was the Minister for Agriculture, Government of Karnataka, himself, an agricultural technologist was responsible to sanction an amount of Rs.10.00 lakhs to build another block.

Although Late Dr. H.R. Arakeri initiated the idea of starting the Forum – Institution of Agricultural

Technologists for the graduates in agricultural sciences, he could not see the glory of the IAT due to his untimely death. The IAT has celebrated its Golden Jubilee in the year 2018 and it has now more than 4500 members. The foresight of Dr. H.R. Arakeri has resulted in establishing this great Institution which is serving the interests of agricultural technologists as well as farmers.

IAT has a dedicated a well-equipped modern hall in the memory of Dr. H.R. Arakeri now.

He also served as the Chairman of, Agriculture Science Recruitment Board, Delhi

In Dharwad, he established Institute for Studies on Agriculture and Rural Development (ISSARD) which celebrated the Centinary of Dr. H.R. Arakeri recently.

A great visionary, Dr. Arakeri was the Founder President of IAT & led it from the front and nurtured it so well, IAT has grown as one of the premier institutions in the countryin taking forward the issues pertaining to agriculture, agriculture sciences & agriculturists of modern era.

IAT salutes proudly the great scientist in the year of his centenary & its founder president.

State Dept. of Agriculture, Dept. of Watershed, Food Karnataka Ltd and AME Foundation, Bengaluru

Ms. M.B. Leelavathi, Food Technologist, Bengaluru urged that our daily menu should include consumption of sea food and regional food in order to maintain a healthy body. In addition, she also advised that local extraction method of oil &indigenous storage technology should be strengthened in case of neglected oil seed like Niger besides. Organic farming and



IFS farming may will increase the nutritional value & ensure food security, if encouraged properly, Ms. Leelavathi felt.

Earlier, inaugurating the World Food Day-2019, Mr. Padmaya Naik, Director, Watershed Development Department expressed his concern that agricultural land is decreasing while the population is swelling resulting in shortage of staple food. An Agricultural Policy curtailing theconversion of fertile land for industrial purposesis the need of the hour, he contended.

Mr. B. Shivaraju, M.D, KAPPEC and Vice President, IAT, Bengaluru, while delivering the guest talk informed the IATians that the novel techniques of crop survey in the state of Karnataka which has been initiated by the Department of Agriculture, would pave the way for benefitting the farmers in terms of claiming the insurance besides estimating the total productivity of the particular crop in order to provide market linkages in case of eventuality. Workshop on ZBNF flags important concerns too

n the One Day Workshop on Zero Budget Natural Farming (ZBNF)

organized jointly on 4th Oct, 2019 by Department of Agriculture, other line departments, all the farm universities & IAT, many suggestions & concerns were taken up for discussion by the participating farmer representatives, scientists from Farm Universities, Development Department Officers and IATns & NGOs at Dr. H.R. Arakeri Auditorium, IAT, Bengaluru.

The major focus of the workshop was to find out the relevance of Zero Budget Natural Farming method of cultivation evolved by Mr. Subhash Palekar over the last two decades and its practicability.

Dr. M.B. Chetti, Vice Chancellor, University of Agricultural Sciences, Dharwad in his inaugural address said that there is a need for validating the beneficial / harmful effects of ZBNF in the state of Karnataka for the benefit of farming community in a long run. Quoting the views of Former Director General of ICAR., he stated that ZBNF may not ensure food securityin view of the ever-swellingpopulation, though it is possible to provide nutrition to a small chunk of people.

Dr. G. Eswarappa, Vice President, IAT highlighted on the subject of Zero Budget Natural Farming in his introductory remarks.

While Dr. M.A. Shankar, former Director of Research, UAS-B and M.C. member, welcomed the gathering, the program was presided over by Prof. V. Veerabhadraiah, former Director of Extension and President, IAT, Bengaluru. Mr. R. Ramamurthy, Secretary, IAT propsed a vote of thanks.

Farm Scientists from UAS-Bengaluru, UAS-Dharwad & UAHS Shivamogga and UHS Bagalkot presented their research findings in three Technical Sessions that followed the inauguration.

Technical Session I

The concept, method and procedure of ZBNF as propounded by Mr. Subash Palekar was presented in detail by Dr. T.K. Prabhakar Setty, former Director of Research, UAS (B). The perceived controversy about ZBNF prompted many questions from participants. The positives and negatives were explained by Dr. Prabhakar Setty. It was evident from the discussion that quite a few participants had reservations about the ZBNF method in comparison to a variety of recommended Zone wise production technologies available in Karnataka.

Technical Session II

The session provided an opportunity to the participant farmers to share their experience about ZBNF as practiced by them. The farmers who made their oral presentations are Sriyuts (i) Amith Vishwanath Kulkarni (Belagavi), (ii) Padmanabha Kulcha (Dakshina Kannada), (iii) Mruthyunjaya (Tumakuru), (iv) Upendrappa (Chintamani), (v) Mahadevaswamy (Chamarajanagara), (vi) Rajashekar, (vii) Nataraj (Koratagere), and (viii)

Prasanna Murthy (Byrasandra). Being new to the method and its practice, their experience sharing was confined to qualitative judgments. However, they were all enthusiastic about trying the method as a promising alternative.

Technical Session III

The Scientific validation of the ZBNF has been already initiated in the respective Universities in the State. Scientists presented their preliminary data obtained from field level testing in different agro-climatic zones. The testing of the ZBNF would require repetition for 4-5 years for critical assessment. Video presentation by scientists enabled the participants to appreciate the intricacies of research methodology.

CONCERNS

The questions and answers part in the sessions did flag some important concerns as under:

- (I) With an ever increasing population agricultural production must be sustained at an increasing level. This is a competing & compelling challenge.
- (ii) Doubling of farmers' income is a stated goal. However, production under ZBNF is admittedly, reduced. This can impact the challenges negatively.
- (iii) ZBNF at present, is scientifically unsubstantiated. This fact can limit its wider acceptance by farmers.

SUGGESTION

In order to assure credibility, concurrent evaluation of the program by an independent expert group is advisable.

A wide range of other innovative services OLA/UBER Apps exclusively for the use of farmers is also designed. Using this app, farmers can hire farm machinery/equipment at competitive rates. Farmers can book in advance for any farm equipment and plan/schedule their farming activities"


